(San Francisco, CA, April 6, 2023) - The 2023 Yerba Buena Gardens Festival announces its lineup of free outdoor music, theater, circus, dance, poetry, and children's programs at Yerba Buena Gardens. The 23rd edition of the Festival opens with the John Santos Sextet + The Afro-Peruvian Coalition on Saturday, May 6, 2023 at 1:00pm and will run through August 2023. Yerba Buena Gardens is located in downtown San Francisco between 3rd and 4th Streets and Mission and Howard Streets.

Yerba Buena Gardens Festival highlights include CO-LLAB Choir directed by Cava Menzies on May 13, CAAMFest: Directions in Sounds presents Fanny on May 20, Theatre Rhino's *Pericles* on May 26 and 27, Melissa Cruz Flamenco on June 3, SF Uke Jam's Summer Uke-Splosion on June 10, La Mezcla + Laura Rebolloso on June 17, Circus Bella's *Bananas* on June 23 and 24, Yosvany Terry Quintet & Gema Corredera + Arun Ramamurthy Trio on July 1, Get Free Festival on July 8, Joe Bataan + La Doña on July 15, AfroSolo Arts Festival presents Martin Luther McCoy on August 5, Pistahan's 30th Anniversary on August 12 and 13, and more.

"I am thrilled that we can once again gather in the Gardens to experience so many of our local Bay Area artists and international artists right in the heart of San Francisco," said Yerba Buena Gardens Festival Executive/Artistic Director Linda Lucero. "This year, the Festival is launching an exciting new Fall Series and we are so grateful we can also continue our very important commissioning programs in order to further support artists. We look forward to seeing everyone in the Gardens!"

For over two decades, the Yerba Buena Gardens Festival has awarded commissions to actively support the creation and presentation of original works by the Bay Area's most innovative and influential artists. In 2020, the Festival celebrated its 20th Anniversary by creating the Endurance, Hope, and Community Commissioning program that awarded unrestricted "mini-commissions" to 20 Bay Area artists. In 2022, the Festival awarded SEED Commissions of \$2,500 to an additional 20 artists to act as "seeds" for the creative process. This year, the Festival continues the SEED program by awarding commissions to an additional 20 artists with many of them performing at this year's Festival.

This year's Festival season introduces a new Fall Series in September and October that will begin with YBG ChoreoFest presented over two weekends - Saturday, September 23 and Saturday, September 30. The full Fall Series lineup will be announced this summer. YBG ChoreoFest is a two-weekend festival of site-specific work that showcases the creativity, diversity, and vibrancy of the Bay Area dance scene. Programmed by RAWdance for its first five years, YBG ChoreoFest opens a new chapter with ChoreoFest now co-curated by David Herrera Performance Company and PUSH Dance Company. RAWdance Co-Artistic Directors Wendy Rein and Ryan Smith say, "When we first started curating YBG ChoreoFest in 2017, we had no idea it would turn into such a wonderful long-lasting relationship. We are proud of being a part of bringing nearly 30 dance companies to the pathways and plazas of the Gardens. The Bay Area is home to a wonderfully diverse array of dance makers and we are excited to see who David and PUSH bring into the space."

**Salsa at Jessie**, the open-air salsa dance party in Jessie Square (near the Contemporary Jewish Museum), takes place on the third Thursday of each month from May to August from 6:00pm – 7:30pm. The series includes **Danilo y Orquesta Universal** on May 18, **Cabanijazz Project** on June 15, **Karl Perazzo & Mike Spiro y su Conjunto Karabalí** on July 20, and **Bululú** on August 17.

Yerba Buena Gardens Festival Children's Garden Series features interactive performances specially designed for kids and their adults every Friday with two performances at 11:00am and 12:15pm. The Series runs from June to August in the Yerba Buena Children's Garden at Fourth and Howard Streets. The kiddie-popular series presents RhythmALLogy on June 9, Ka-Hon on June 16, Circus Bella's Bananas on Friday, June 23 and Saturday, June 24 with the performances on the Esplanade inYerba Buena Gardens, Unique Derique on June 30, Chelle! & Friends on July 7, Circus of Smiles on July 14, René y Familia on July 21, Calvin Kai Ku on July 28, Caterpillar Puppets on August 4, Red Panda Acrobats on August 11. The series ends with the popular 23rd Annual Halloween Hoopla on Saturday, October 28.

Thursday Lunchtime Concert Series takes place Thursdays from 12:30pm to 1:30pm and features local and international musicians including Ajyal Music Platform on May 11, Tom Rigney & Flambeau on May 18, CMC Older Adults Choir on May 25, The Howard Wiley Show on June 1, Anita Lofton Project on June 8, Bongo Sidibe & the TonTons on June 15, Jenny Lind Concert on June 22, ASTU on June 29, Rob Reich Swings Left on July 6, Big Trippin on July 13, KOHAKU on July 20, Aki Kumar on July 27, La Gente SF on August 3, Salma El Assal & the Sudan Ensemble on August 10, and Alessandro Penezzi & Fabiana Cozza on August 17.

**Poetic Tuesdays** are the twice monthly line-up of poets and musicians at Jessie Square from 12:30pm to 1:30pm. Curated on the 2nd Tuesdays by Litquake and the 4th Tuesdays by MoAD, the Poetic Tuesdays series begins Tuesday, May 9.

The Yerba Buena Gardens Festival will host annual cultural celebrations, partner programs, and classes including Yoga with Purusha Yoga, Dance Outdoors with Rhythm & Motion, and salsa classes with Rueda Con Ritmo, Yerba Buena Gardens Public Art Tours, 25th Annual Native Contemporary Arts Festival on June 18, Embodiment Project's Get Free Festival on July 8, Fiestas Fridas on July 22, AfroSolo Arts Festival with Martin Luther McCoy on August 5, and Pistahan's 30th Anniversary on August 12 and 13.
